#### **Protect Yourself from Scams (Humana)**

#### **Continuing our information on scams:**

There are several ways that we can be scammed.

Type of Scam	How it works	How to protect yourself.
Funeral and cemetery scams	Scammers may act as mysterious debt collectors, corrupt funeral homes may tack on extras, or you may get a phishing email.	Don't give anyone money, especially if they cannot prove a debt is owed. Find help when planning a funeral and don't be pressured into making a purchase. If you receive an email, call the funeral home directly to verify someone has passed away.
Sweepstakes and lottery scams	Scammers inform the victim that they have won a lottery or sweepstakes but need to make a payment to "unlock" the prize. They may also send a fake check to deposit and collect "taxes and fees" before it bounces.	sounds too good to be true,
The grandparent scam.	Scammers calls pretending to be a grandchild who needs help now – often by way of a cashier's check or money order.	Contact your grandchild using the number you have for them to see if they story holds up. Call the child's parents, even the grandchild has asked you not to. Ask the person key questions to verify their identity.
Fake charities	Scammers claim to represent a charity in need of money for a specific cause. The charities are often bogus or only contribute a small amount.	Always do your homework before donating to a charity and only give to those you've fully investigated. Visit www.charitynavagator.org

		(or call 201-818-1288) to look into the charity you'd like to give to more closely. Watch the news for reports of fraudulent organizations. Add your number to the do -not-call list
Tech support scams	Scammers tell you that your computer has a problem, and you need to click to "fix" it – which usually requires your credit card.	Don't click on pop-ups unless you're sure it is from a legitimate antivirus company. Don't trust phone calls made to you. Large companies wait for you to call them. If you do get scammed, consider taking your computer to a local repair company.

**Continued next month.** I thought I was aware and savvy to not be scammed until I was. I lost a few hundred dollars thinking I was helping someone I knew. I'm much more reluctant to help people with a phone call and to answer the phone if I don't know who's calling. Sad that this is the world we live in.
